Notes on the Completion of TC Form 1

The following explanatory notes provide specific guidance on the completion of TC Form 1. Please read them carefully before completing your application.

Box 1. Details of Applicant

An applicant means an importer or exporter who is applying for an advance ruling on tariff classification on a good that will be imported into or exported from the Philippines. All required information should be provided. The name of the authorized representative (e.g., agent) and his/her email address should be indicated, if applicable. A written authorization bearing the signatures of the applicant and authorized representative should also be submitted (see template).

Box 2. Contact Person for Technical Information

At any time during the evaluation of the good, the Commission may require clarification or additional information from the applicant. He/she should thus designate a contact person with access to technical information about the good.

Box 3. Details of Good

The product/trade name is the name by which the good is known to traders and manufacturers and/or which is indicated in the import/export documents.

For imports, the country of origin refers to the country or state where the good was produced or manufactured, and not the port of origin. This information is needed for determining the tariff preference under the Free Trade Agreements to which the Philippines is a party.

Applicants may indicate the tariff classification (Harmonized System code) of the good in the country of origin, if known, and attach supporting documents.

If the product has previously been issued with an Advance Ruling, applicants should indicate the TCC (AR) No. and attach a copy of the ruling, if available.

The description provided should be sufficient to enable the good to be identified. The applicant may include information about the composition of the good, its production process, properties, structure, function, intended use, packaging, safety information, and other pertinent information.

Box 5. Submissions

Any samples, technical catalogs/brochures, duly certified complete composition, plans, photographs or other documents available, which may assist in determining the correct classification of the good, should be submitted. Written materials submitted should be signed by the applicant or authorized representative on each page.

Samples not in retail packaging should conform to the following specifications:

Sample Characteristics	Required Volume/Quantity	Primary Packaging/Container	Secondary Packaging/Container
Odoriferous and highly reactive to light	250 mL (liquid) 100g (solid)	Amber glass bottles	Resealable clear plastic bag
Odoriferous but not highly reactive to light	250 mL (liquid) 100 g (solid)	Clear glass bottles	Resealable clear plastic bag
Other forms (e.g., powder, granules, pellets)	100 g	Clear plastic or glass bottles	Resealable clear plastic bag

Box 6. Certification and Undertaking

By printing his/her name and affixing his/her signature in TC Form 1, the applicant certifies that all information and submissions are true and correct and relate to the good being applied for advance tariff classification ruling or tariff classification dispute ruling.

Furthermore, the applicant commits that any additional information required will be submitted within 10 calendar days after receipt of request from the Commission. Non-submission will render the application cancelled.

Upon issuance of the AR, the sample will be released to the applicant. The applicant is required to retain the sample for 15 days and keep it in the same sealed condition as it was received, to give time for any possible appeals on the released ruling.

If the applicant intends to appeal the ruling, the returned sample shall be re-submitted to the Commission, upon request, in the same sealed condition as when it was received, along with the appeal.

Box 7. Result of Initial Assessment (For TC Use Only)

The TC Tariff Specialist will indicate the lacking document/s or information and/or reason for non-acceptance of the application if it was not endorsed for payment to the Cashier.

Additional notes:

1. Pursuant to Section 1103 of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), an application for an advance ruling on tariff classification shall cover one product or item only. It shall be filed at least 90 days before the importation or exportation of the product or item.
2. An advance ruling on tariff classification is not a decision on whether or not the good may be a prohibited or regulated import/export. It is the responsibility of the importer/exporter to ensure that the good is not prohibited and secure the required import/export clearance if the good is regulated.
3. Any confidential information should be properly marked.
