Pursuant to Section 1603 (e) of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), questions on Non-Tariff Measures (NTMs) are incorporated into this Form to provide TC with information on the most common NTM/s applied to certain products as well as the challenges faced by companies in complying with the same. The information gathered will help TC to gain better understanding of the effects of NTMs on international trade and on the price/s and quantity/ies of traded products.
